According to our By-Laws, Article IV, Section 4E: "Additional nominations may be made at the May Meeting by any member in attendance provided that the person so nominated does not decline when his name is proposed, and provided further that if the proposed candidate is not in attendance at this meeting, his proposer shall present to the Secretary a written statement from the proposed candidate signifying his willingness to be a candidate. No person may be a candidate for more than one position, and the additional nominations which are provided for herein may be made only from those members who have not accepted a nomination of the Nominating Committee."

Elections of the new Officers and Board Members will be held at the June 2005 Meeting by secret, written ballot from those nominated in accordance with Section 4 of Article IV. They shall take office immediately upon the conclusion of the election. Only members who are in good standing, whose dues are paid for the current year, are entitled to vote.
